Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 2898 for *Eighty* acres, issued in favor of *Green Smith Private in Captain (Welder's) Company Tennessee* *Florida War*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *North fractional half of the North West quarter of Section eighteen in Township Eighty North of Range Twenty three West in the district of Lands Subject to Sale at New City Texas containing Eighty Eight Acres and Ten hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *which has been assigned to Nathan Shouster*

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Nathan Shouster*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Nathan Shouster and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
